! Documents you need to bring !

- **Proof of qualifications, including exam result slips or certificates, including English and maths.**
- **Proof of residency, which could include:**

- o A UK passport.

- o eVisa documentation, including passport/visa of family member if your visa states you are joining someone else. We must also see your visa stating the name of the person you are joining.

- o EU Settlement scheme for EU citizens.

- o Home Office letter stating that your application is being processed if your current visa is expiring. If your visa expires before the end of your course, you may not be able to fully enrol or complete your course.

For 19+ Years Old, additionally:

- **National insurance number, unless you are an asylum seeker. You will be charged the full cost of the course if you cannot provide an NI number.**
- **Payment method to pay for any fees due (we do not accept cheques or cash).**

If you live in a London postcode area and are earning below £27,007.50, or live outside of London and earn below £25,750.00, we will need to see wage slips or your employment contract stating your annual salary.

STEP 2: Application

If you don't make an application or your results aren't as expected, go to **the Application area - room 223**, and the Support Team will help you to choose the course.
